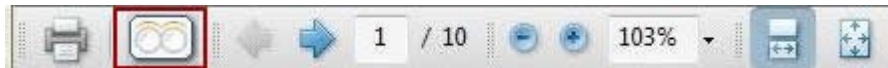
PdfReader.Now client for WhereIsNow

PdfReader.Now is a client for the WhereIsNow WebService (<http://www.whereisnow.com>) which allows you to know where is the latest version of a pdf document.

The only requirement for this application is Acrobat Reader 8.0 or later.

Step 1 – Let's try...

Once you have installed PdfReader.Now, run Acrobat Reader and load a document. You can find the latest version of the document just clicking over this button:

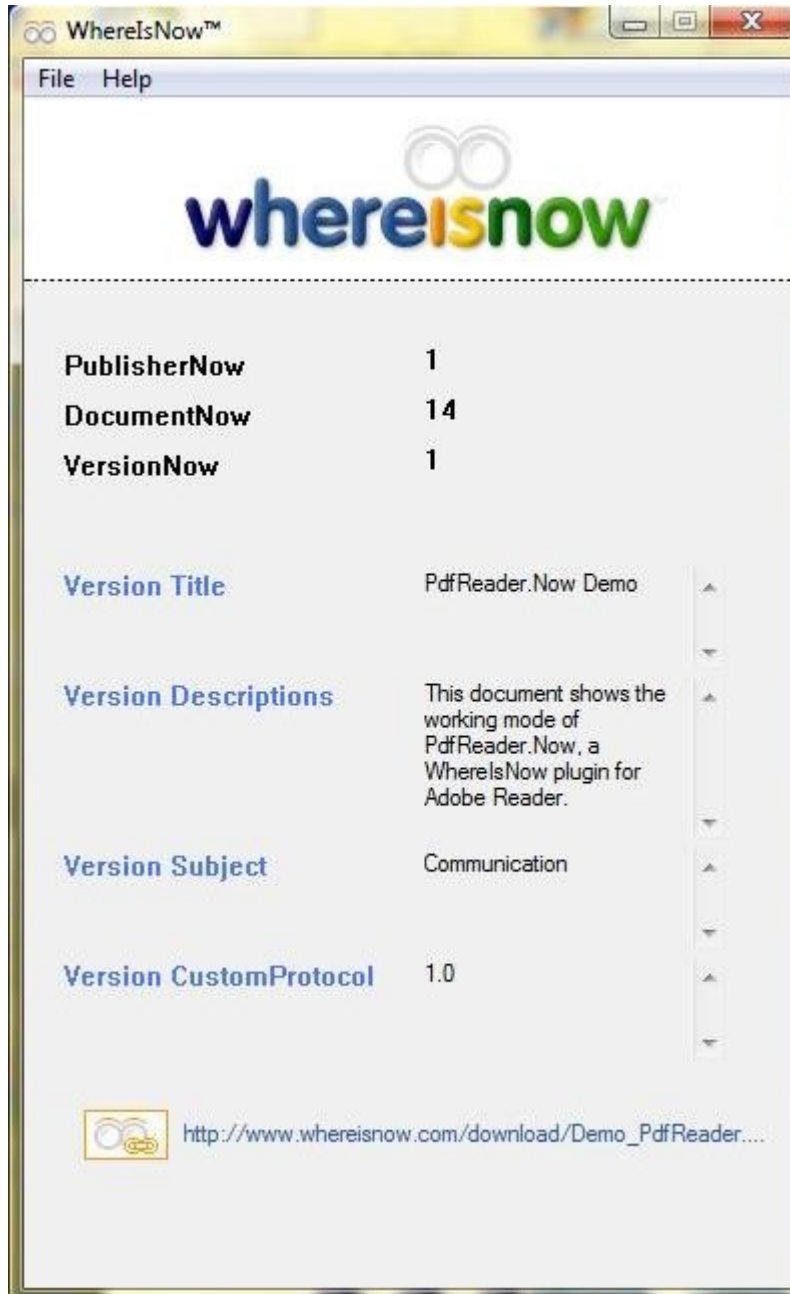


The client will extract WhereIsNow keys from your document, then it will query the WhereIsNow WebService.

But attention, your file does not contain WhereIsNow keys! Don't worry, you can set them using Desk.Now client, go download it at <http://www.whereisnow.com/KeySearch.now?publisher=1&document=3>

Step 2 – The button has been clicked

For example, if you open the [Demo_PdfReader.Now.pdf](#), by clicking the button you can see the query results like these:



It may happen that you get a *reserved* URL in your query results, but...

... What does the *SignIn* button mean?

A reserved URL is an URL that a publisher has made available only for WhereIsNow registered users. By clicking on SignIn button, a little login window like this will be shown:



Inserting email and password of your WhereIsNow account, you will be able to see even the details of reserved URLs.

Now you know how to use PdfReader.Now, install it and try with this pdf document...
